



Gahanna's Farmers Market Policies and Guidelines:

- All ready-to-eat foods must be pre-packaged before arriving at market.
- Samples are permitted. Samples must be individually packaged.
- Vendor stands will operate with increased space between stalls
- Marking paint (chalk where applicable) will be used to lay out social distancing markers for lines to vendors.

Volunteer and Vendor Employee Guidelines and Policies:

- Sick volunteers and vendors employees must stay home and not return until they are free of fever for at least 14 days without fever-reducing medication and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath)
- Volunteers and vendors who appear to be ill upon arrival to market or become sick during the day will be sent home immediately.
- It is REQUIRED for all volunteers to wear a facemask\* as directed by the CDC recommendation:

Vendor Guidelines and Policies:

- All vendors should sanitize their stands regularly, primarily wiping down tables, terminals, cash boxes, etc. Familiarize yourself with the CDC Guidelines to clean and disinfect surfaces here: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/disinfecting-building-facility.html>
- It is recommended to only use materials that can be immediately washed and sanitized after use. (plastic tablecloths and plastic containers)
- Clean/sanitize your hands frequently, and follow CDC recommendations for cleaning your hands.
- All vendors must have hand sanitizer at their tables.
- Please select and bag items for shoppers, where applicable.
- It is encouraged to take pre-paid orders where shoppers can pick-up their order at the market but not required.

### Customer Engagement Guidelines:

- It is REQUIRED that all shoppers wear a facemask\* as directed by CDC recommendations: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/diy-cloth-face-coverings.html>
- Customers with a previous illness must stay home and not return to the market until they are free of fever and show improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath) for at least 14 days and at least 14 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available and every person entering the market.
- Shoppers must practice the recommended 6' social distancing from one another while at the market.
- Shoppers should not touch any products, rather allowing the vendor to select and bag products customers wish to purchase, when applicable.
- Clean/sanitize your hands frequently. Follow CDC recommendations for cleaning your hands.

\*Facemasks are still required by the State of Ohio for all persons outside of their home, at this time. We will follow the latest mandates from the State of Ohio when it comes to facemasks and safety protocols.
